JOYCE G bumped with CONSIDER THEMAYX at the break, was settled, gradually progressed two or three wide, put to a drive entering the lane, moved in beside WINDS DUE EAST as she went for the lead upper stretch and shook off that one inside the final sixteenth. SONGANDDANCELADY steadily advanced from inside, altered out three wide for a clear path upper stretch, slowly closed the gap and caught WINDS DUE EAST for second nearing the wire. WINDS DUE EAST jostled briefly with VELVET ACCOUNT as she went for the lead into the first bend, soon moved clear, showed the way from inside on the backstretch, was challenged in the stretch, slowly yielded the last eighth but proved easily best of the rest. CONSIDER THEMAYX bumped with JOYCE G at the start, raced in contention outside WINDS DUE EAST, floated out to path four entering the lane, flattened and was gradually drifting out deep stretch. YUKON'S LIBERTY away slowly, was widest throughout and failed to menace. VELVET ACCOUNT broke alertly, jostled briefly with WINDS DUE EAST as those two were vying for the lead into the first turn, could not stay with the latter leaving that bend and steadily gave way from paths three or four once on the backstretch. PEORIA STAR gradually retreated while not far off the inside on the backstretch, took the rail into the second turn and continued to fade.
