Footnotes

KITTEN'S RULE soon had a clear lead, showed the way from inside, was roused and floated out to path three entering the lane and held sway under steady urging. RAP ON FELIX settled off the inside, picked up his pace after a half mile, progressed just off the rail on the second bend, altered out for room midstretch, angled in again for a clear path with a sixteenth left, closed well and got second. GIVING POINTS chased the early speed from just off the inside, fanned outside the leader entering the stretch, had every chance but ran evenly. DR. CALAHAN steadily progressed from inside to threaten with a furlong left but hung in the waning yards. BOIS D'ARC FOREST gradually angled in on the backstretch, came off the rail some to advance on the second bend then weakened the last eighth. SECRETO'S GOLD void of speed, though hustled along, stayed well off the inside and only passed tired ones in the lane. SOUP MAN without speed from inside, closed the gap some on the second turn, altered out three wide near the quarter pole for a clear path then lacked a significant stretch bid. TRADE DEFICIT forwardly placed between horses, faded from inside leaving the second turn. ADDAWAY RAJ five wide on the first turn, raced in contention from outside on the backstretch but gave way just off the rail on the second bend.
