### Footnotes

SIX GUN ROYAL away slowly, was then steadied behind traffic, advanced between rivals, waited for room on the turn, his rider lost his whip leaving the quarter pole, got through along the rail into the lane, gained a slight advantage, battled under a hand ride and held on. WINNINGCHEROKEE chased while toward the outside, lost ground five and six wide taking the bend, steadily advance while all out in the stretch and narrowly missed. BLING KING bobbled inward, bumping PICK ME POSH, set the pace just off the inside, was challenged from both sides in the lane and slowly yielded deep stretch. IVAN'S JOY pressed from inside, fanned outside BLING KING entering the stretch, closed the gap but hung the final sixteenth. BROTHER DAN forwardly placed just outside BLING KING, flattened out for the drive. BEAUCOUP GOLD bumped with GREYHAWK at the start, was just off the inside taking the bend, made up ground through upper stretch then leveled off. SMOKIN SILVER was an early factor between rivals but faded four wide on the turn. PICK ME POSH bumped and forced inward at the start, chased from outside, was widest taking the turn, gradually angled in through the stretch but had no late bid. GREYHAWK bumped with BEAUCOUP GOLD at the break, was void of speed from inside, fanned out to path three into the lane and was empty. NO SONG N DANCE was soon far back and well off the inside and hand ridden through the stretch.
