Footnotes

JOHNNY CADILLAC rated just off the inside the leaders and the rail, commenced his bid two wide entering the lane, took over inside the furlong marker, was clear nearing the final sixteenth and kept to task to the waning yards. CAUSE CAUSE CAUSE rated outside the early speed, stayed in path four as he went for the lead on the second bend, had a slight advantage upper stretch, no match for JOHNNY CADILLAC in the late going but lasted for the place under steady urging. MINING FOR SILVER settled, gradually advanced along the rail, came off the inside some for the stretch run, was under a drive as he followed behind JOHNNY CADILLAC and caught BIG SIX for third near the wire. BIG SIX was quickly clear, showed the way from inside, challenged on the second turn, battled for second inside the last eighth but grudgingly yielded. ARDANWOOD progressed between horses on the backstretch, was four wide into the second bend, angled in some entering the lane, threatened with a furlong to go, fought for third deep stretch, was narrowly outfinished but easily best of the others. YONA TORY void of speed while not far off the inside, was forced in early in the second turn, progressed just off the rail to midstretch then leveled off. ESPRESSO DOBLE away slowly, trailed from outside, moved to the rail on the second turn and passed some tired ones upper stretch. SOON chased while toward the outside for a half mile, angled in entering the second turn, faded just off the rail, floated out some for the stretch run and lugged in late. SALT MINER in contention early, came off the rail once on the backstretch, steadily gave way between horses after a half mile, swung out widest into the stretch and continued to fade. STORMY JIM failed to menace in a wide trip.
