TOKENS ONLY kept close just off inside on the backstretch, had the rail into the bend, swung out leaving the turn, rallied the last eighth and got up in time. UNO BLISS soon had the lead from inside, was challenged on the turn, shook free upper stretch, was all out, outfinished but easily second best. BARELY FRIENDS pressed the early speed from outside, went for the lead just outside UNO BLISS on the bend, could not stay with that one upper stretch, gradually yielded but lasted for the show. DONTFLATERYOURSELF caught in close quarters nearing the half mile marker, was checked, altered outside, advanced four wide on the turn then leveled off for the drive. TYLER'S GOLD STAR in contention toward the outside on the backstretch, gradually angled in as she tired through the turn. MAXXINISTA SANDEE forwardly placed between horses early, gave way three wide on the turn, floated out widest entering the lane and had little left. JOMELMA chased the early speed while hustled along from between rivals, faded just off the inside on the turn and continued to tire through the stretch. TROPICAL ROBBERY showed first, was soon chasing UNO BLISS from just outside, angled out three wide into the bend, began to fade, went lame leaving the turn, was pulled up and vanned off.
