BUDDYLIGHT soon had a clear lead, showed the way inside in hand, received some mild urging midstretch and proved best ridden out. ONE WILD CAT raced closest to the pacesetter from between horses, just off the inside taking the second bend, all out in the lane, proved no match for the leader but was easily second best. EL POO bumped with ZEN TO WIN shortly after the break, raced in contention from outside, was three wide through the second turn, drifted out entering the stretch and steadily pulled away from the rest without threatening the top pair. EUROPA'S BEST steadied and shuffled back from tight quarters into the first turn, advanced between horses, just off the inside on the second bend, floated out some for the drive and ran evenly the last quarter mile. DIXIE'S MICHAEL soon trailed, swung out on the second turn, came widest into the lane and only passed tired ones. ZEN TO WIN bumped and forced into PENNY EARNED shortly after the start, improved position some from outside on the backstretch, was four wide taking the second bend and had no late bid. PENNY EARNED bumped shortly after the break, raced in midpack early from between horses but began to tire three wide on the second turn. AGILE SAINT squeezed between rivals into the first turn, was checked, advanced inside on the first turn but began to give way before finishing a half mile.
