**Footnotes**

HEARTBREAKINLOOKS vied for the lead from outside, four wide on the turn, came to M P FLASH upper stretch, was brushed by that one inside the final furlong and drew off the last sixteenth. M P FLASH bumped at the start, contested the pace between horses, moved ahead and stayed just off the inside on the turn, floated out some entering the stretch, was challenged from outside, drifted out a bit inside the furlong marker, brushed HEARTBREAKINLOOKS, was checked briefly near the sixteenth marker, did not sufficiently recover but was unchallenged for second. RIDE THIS NOTE a step slow at the break, bumped with RIB MOUNTAIN a few strides later, saved ground taking the bend, bid two wide in the lane, battled for third and edged out ILLINI DESTINY for that position late. ILLINI DESTINY in contention toward the outside on the backstretch, failed to keep up three wide on the turn, fanned out to path five for the drive, regained a striking position upper stretch but lacked the needed response, fought for third instead and missed. CURIOUS GENIUS hesitated then made a small leap from the gate, trailed, was just off the inside on the turn, swung out some entering the lane, altered out six wide for room upper stretch and passed tired ones. WHAMMY'S BOY bumped with M P FLASH at the break, gradually angled in as he chased the pacesetters, was two and three wide taking the bend then flattened out in the lane. RIB MOUNTAIN also a step slow at the start, bumped with RIDE THIS NOTE a few stride out of the gate, rushed up inside to duel for the lead, could not keep up along the rail on the turn and gave way the last furlong. TOTALLY UNREAL contested the pace between rivals on the backstretch, failed to keep up into the turn, gradually angled out on the bend, came into the stretch from the middle of the track and steadily faded.
