Footnotes

STILETTO HEELS without early speed, advanced from inside on the turn, altered out four wide for a clear path upper stretch, made a strong move and swept past WILDLY LANA nearing the wire. WILDLY LANA broke alertly, set the pace just off the inside, took the rail on the bend, lengthened command upper stretch but began to weaken and drift out the last eighth. TWO BIT BANDIT pressed WILDLY LANA first from inside then two wide on the bend, lacked the extra needed in the lane and gradually angled out as WILDLY LANA did in the late going. CAP'N SWIFTER prominent between horses, was three wide leaving the turn, weakened in the lane and also gradually came out trying to keep a clear path the final furlong. BE DARING trailed, picked up her pace just off the inside on the bend, swung four wide into the lane and passed between tiring rivals. SHAYLINS DANCER forwardly placed between rivals, lost ground four then five wide taking the turn and faded the last quarter mile. SCARLET TEE in contention early, had the rail on the turn, came off the inside some for the drive and also flattened out. MIDNIGHT KUGER without speed from outside, was just off the rail on the turn, swung widest for the stretch run and had little to offer. JOHN D'S VALENTINE was a factor from outside on the backstretch but gave way three wide on the turn.
