PHONE JOAN broke alertly, set a pressured pace two wide, was headed on the second turn, regained the advantage leaving the eighth pole and edged clear the final sixteenth. TURKISH ECHO rated three wide for more than a half mile, bid for the lead on the second turn, got the advantage leaving the bend, battled through the lane but did not have enough left. PIXIE POO advanced inside on the backstretch, was swung out for room on the second turn, four wide into the stretch, loomed a threat at the eighth pole but leveled off late. MISSISSAUGAS MAGIC contested the pace inside to the second turn then gradually wore down. MARJORIE V. three to four wide throughout, lodged a mild bid into the stretch but also weakened the final furlong. EISHIN ILLINI NOW at the back and outside, was angled in two wide on the second turn, fanned out four wide for the stretch run but had little to offer. CALEDON COLLEEN was angled in early on for room and showed little.
