Footnotes

BLACKHAWK RED was sent to share the lead from inside, rated on the backstretch, drew clear when let out on the second turn, was roused at the quarter pole then steadily lengthened command under a drive in the lane. FAST HUTCH forwardly placed outside, was three wide taking the second turn, moved clear for second just off the inside upper stretch but could only just hold his position late. ETHICAL LAWYER bumped several times with ONLY OBLONG at the break, gradually progressed just off the inside, fanned three wide for the drive, made up minor ground the last eighth and was getting to the weakening FAST HUTCH. GOLD DE LAC shared the early lead from outside, could not stay with BLACKHAWK RED while just off the inside on the second turn, took the rail into the stretch and gradually yielded. ONLY OBLONG bumped then jostled between horses at the break, was steadied, showed no speed from inside, came off the rail some on the second turn and had no stretch bid. BEE'S BUCKAROO soon trailed, moved out widest on the backstretch, lost ground through the second turn and lacked a significant stretch response. GRAND PROCESSION void of early speed, angled in near the half mile marker, saved ground taking the second bend and lacked a rally in the lane. BRAZEN GEORGE displayed briefly speed between rivals, began to fade before finishing a half mile, saved ground through the second turn, distanced himself in the stretch and was walked off.
