Footnotes

RAY JAY pressed from outside, moved up to share to the lead just outside SULTRY DEMEANOR on the bend, was all out through the lane, gained a slight advantage inside the furlong marker and shook free in the waning yards. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE without early speed, swung out four wide trying to gain a clear path on the bend, was forced to fan to path six for room into the lane, closed well and caught SULTRY DEMEANOR for the place nearing the wire. SULTRY DEMEANOR showed first, was challenged from outside on the turn, came off the rail some entering the stretch, fought gamely but did not have enough left late. ILLINI MO well back early, picked up his pace along the rail on the bend, made a strong move through the stretch but came up short. HONKY TONK GOLD fractious in the gate, was an early factor, three then four wide through the turn, had every chance in the lane but lacked the extra needed. SPURTABILITY chased from outside, was forced six wide on the turn then wider into the lane and only made up minor ground late. U K WILDCAT prominent from outside, was forced four wide on the bend, fanned further entering the stretch then gave way. LITTLEBITEVEN without speed between rivals, was forced five wide and caught in tight quarters between rivals on the turn, altered in at the head of the lane, quit, was eased inside the last furlong and walked off.
