Footnotes

PLEASE BOUNDARY kept close toward the outside, was checked when her path narrowed early in the turn, progressed four wide soon after, fanned out further into the lane, altered in for a clear path upper stretch, took over the lead after entering the final sixteenth and began to draw off. RAVE AND RICHES disputed the pace between horses, moved ahead three wide on the turn, floated out further entering the lane, drifted out upper stretch, was corrected, held a straight path the last eighth, could not hold back PLEASE BOUNDARY in the waning yards but was clearly second best. HARASSMENT in contention between rivals on the backstretch, improved position along the rail on the bend, altered out thee wide upper stretch for a clear path, could not close the gap on the top pair the final furlong but got third. ALISWEEPER soon trailed, lost ground four to six wide taking the turn but closed well. LIL VALRIE SUE TOO without speed from inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, altered off the rail with a sixteenth left, was checked when her path narrowed seventy yards out, split rivals two wide soon after and advanced. MISS BOCEPHUS dueled for the early lead from inside, could not stay with RAVE AND RICHES leaving the bend and gradually wore down along the rail the last eighth. U. S. S. SPENCER contested the pace between horses, failed to keep up two wide leaving the bend, gradually faded through the stretch and was altered out when crowded in the waning yards. LADY LEPRECHAUN was taken inside early on, came off the rail some on the turn, in path three entering the lane and had no late bid. FREEDOM SLEW displayed early speed from outside, gave way on the turn, went lame upper stretch, was eased and vanned off.
