Footnotes

CHOCOLATE GOLD vied for the early lead just outside NANCY'S RAP, backed up some two wide on the turn, rallied deep stretch, had the advantage with a sixteenth to go and edged ahead in the waning yards. NANCY'S RAP sent to contest the pace just off or along the rail, moved ahead on the bend, was all out in the lane but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. HOT DAME well placed just behind NANCY'S RAP, was boxed in and waited for room through the turn, altered out three wide at the top of the lane, could only make up minor ground deep stretch but was clearly best of the rest. APRIL ANN away slowly, advanced from outside, four and five wide taking the turn, drifted out some midstretch, was corrected and lacked a significant bid. HALF MOON BEAUTY gradually angled out looking for a clear path on the backstretch, moved to the rail entering the bend, altered out some upper stretch and had no rally. DAWNS MISTAKE away a bit slowly, as well, showed no speed from inside, came off the rail some for room early in the turn, fanned three wide into the lane, altered inside for a clear path nearing the furlong marker, improved her position but leveled off the last sixteenth. REBA NELL forwardly placed outside, was three then four wide taking the turn then flattened out for the drive. NOBODY LOVES ME steadily faded from between horses on the backstretch, stayed well off the inside through the turn and was empty in the lane.
