Footnotes

BIG MAN HUNGATE contested the pace between horses, did not stay with MONARCH THUNDER while just off the inside on the turn, came again in the lane, was bumped deep stretch but edged ahead nearing the wire. MONARCH THUNDER bumped and forced in at the break, dueled for the lead from inside, moved clear on the turn, was challenged again in the stretch, drifted out late when switched to left-handed pressure, bumped BIG MAN HUNGATE well inside the last sixteenth, was corrected and narrowly outfinished. GOLD ANGEL well placed inside, rallied in the stretch, was blocked inside the last eighth, altered out three wide near the sixteenth marker, closed well, was too late but easily best of the rest. J R'S ADVANTAGE bobbed a bit at the break, bumping GORE CANYON GOLD, raced in contention toward the outside, was three wide on the turn, moved to the inside for the drive, had a striking position with a furlong to go but could only pull clear of the rest late. HI YO SILVER AWAY sent between horses, began to wear down three wide leaving the bend. MATT COLE bumped just after the break, chased from between rivals and faded just off the inside on the turn. SKIPPIN DYLAN broke outward, was prominent from outside on the backstretch but gave way four wide on the bend. ONE FAST MOOCHER broke inward, bumping MONARCH THUNDER, raced forwardly between horses, failed to keep up into the turn, began to drift out, was checked off heels nearing the three-furlong marker, continued to drift once clear and had little left. GORE CANYON GOLD squeezed between horses at the start, was soon well back, had the rail on the turn, floated out into the stretch and was empty.
