Footnotes

ZAVILL rated just off the inside, altered out five wide upper stretch for a clear path and caught HOLY ARMENIA in the final strides. HOLY ARMENIA forwardly placed outside, angled in on the turn, was blocked upper stretch, got through two wide with a furlong to go, gained a narrow lead thirty yards out but was outfinished in a game effort. R RICH E. RICH broke in stride, was challenged from outside after a furlong, shook free leaving the turn, was all out in the lane, began to weaken deep stretch and floated out some. KEYSTONE KID steadied from inside when his path narrowed nearing the bend, continued along the rail, gradually closed the gap and narrowly missed third. PALACE TENOR prominent from outside, was three wide taking the turn then ran evenly through the lane. BEAUCOUP GOLD contested the pace between rivals after the first furlong but wore down two wide when the serious running started. UNEXPECTED VALOR advanced three wide on the bend, swung widest into the stretch and flattened out.
