**Footnotes**

ALABAMA CLAY was hustled along to contest the pace from outside, just off the rail nearing the turn, took the inside on the bend, moved clear leaving the turn, was put to a drive midstretch, lengthened command then allowed to relax the last seventy yards. LUCKY ALEC vied for the lead from inside, was steadied as his path narrowed approaching the turn, was boxed in early in the bend, got through two wide nearing the quarter pole, had every chance through the lane, was no match for the lead but clearly second best. ROYALLY OUTFOXED pressed from outside, was three wide taking the bend, all out in the stretch but could only hold his position late. SABAGO caught in crowding shortly after the break, bumped CAUSE CAUSE CAUSE twice, was just off the inside leaving the turn, altered in for a clear path upper stretch and improved position without threatening. ROYAL INTEGRITY without speed, was three wide on the turn, swung out to path five entering the stretch, advanced to midstretch then gradually lugged in through the late going. NICKEL HIDE was a factor between rivals for more than three furlongs, was just off the inside into the lane then steadily flattened out. CAUSE CAUSE CAUSE bumped twice early and forced in, advanced along the rail on the turn and upper stretch, angled out for a clear path inside the last furlong and leveled off. BULL BAYOU void of speed, gradually angled out through the bend, was widest into the lane and had no late bid. TIME ADOSIOUS a step slow at the break, progressed from outside, was four wide taking the turn then gave way for the drive. DR. KEITH soon trailed, was just off the inside on the turn and unresponsive in the stretch. The rider of LUCKY ALEX lodged an objection alleging interference from ALABAMA CLAY nearing the turn. After their review, the stewards did not uphold that claim.
