**Footnotes**

TACTICS RAP kept close between horses, advanced just off the inside on the turn, was all out between horses in the stretch and got up in time. HONEY BE ORO vied for the lead three wide on the backstretch, angled in on the turn, moved ahead, was clear with a furlong left then began to slowly drift out as she weakened. RIDGEWAY ANGEL a bit slow at the start, progressed three wide on the turn and upper stretch then finished evenly. NOW YOU'RE MAD in tight along the rail on the backstretch, waited for room on the turn and upper stretch, gained a clear path at the eighth pole, lacked the extra needed but was easily best of the rest. SALE NOTES advanced from outside on the turn, came four wide into the lane and gradually wore down. SEATTLE TRAIN in contention between horses early, faded into the turn. CYBERPHOBE vied for the early lead while in tight quarters between horses on the backstretch but tired two wide on the bend.
