### Footnotes

PAPER MAKER shared the lead from outside, was three on the turn, gained a narrow advantage between horses upper stretch then held off his stablemate under steady urging. WINNINGCHEROKEE advanced widest, was four wide through the bend, battled just outside PAPER MAKER through the lane, did not have enough late but was easily second best. DOODLE DANDY disputed the pace between rivals, was just off the inside taking the turn, was no match for PAPER MAKER and WINNINGCHEROKEE in the lane but was unchallenged for the show. PICK ME POSH caught behind traffic nearing the half mile marker, was checked, also just off the inside on the turn, fanned out some entering the stretch, angled out as GRAHM THE BRUISER came out inside the furlong marker then lugged in late. IVAN'S JOY held in check while trying to lug in while between rivals on the backstretch, swung out on the turn, was widest entering the stretch and had no late bid. GRAHM THE BRUISER was sent to contest the pace from inside, began to tire leaving the bend and came out some after entering the last furlong. GREYHAWK was a factor between horses early but faded from path four on the turn.
