PRESENTS FOR BERTI steadily advanced between rivals, moved clear on the backstretch, saved ground on the second turn, floated out as he began to be urged leaving that bend, was under a mild drive in the lane and proved much the best. ANNA'S GLORY saved ground on the first turn, came off the rail some on the backstretch, commenced his bid along the rail on the second bend, floated out a bit entering the lane, moved clear for second upper stretch then could only just hold his position late. MASTER COMMANDER broke alertly, took the rail entering the backstretch, soon lost the lead to PRESENTS FOR BERTI, came off the inside some on the second turn, fanned out as ANNA'S GLORY did leaving that bend, was somewhat slow to respond in the lane, all out in the deep stretch, closed the gap on ANNA'S GLORY and proved easily best of the rest. DEPUTY SREVA void of speed, saved ground throughout and only passed tired ones. KING NEGWER chased just off the inside, moved to the rail midway on the backstretch, came off the inside some for the drive and lacked a late bid. MARKY P in paths three or four throughout, failed to menace. CHOKE HOLD bumped and steadied while in tight between horses going to the first bend, drifted out on the that turn, angled in to be just off the rail on the second bend and was empty for the drive. ILLINI DESTINY bumped CHOKE HOLD shortly after the break, raced in contention from outside but gave way just off the rail on the second turn.
