BUCKS GAMBLE vied for the lead from outside, gained the advantage on the turn, fanned to path three for the stretch run, slowly drifted as he edged ahead, began to bear out despite a right whip in the waning yards but held sway. BOLD STANDARD raced in the second flight between horses, swung outside BUCKS GAMBLE into the lane, slowly angled out as he made his bid, was carried out by the latter in deep stretch and proved clearly second best. RAISE A GENTLEMAN moved up from inside, had a striking position along the rail with a furlong left but could only gain third late. TUNNEL MARTE dueled for the lead from the beginning, had the rail on the turn, came off the inside some entering the stretch and gradually wore down. SINGALONGWITH BERT pressed from outside, three to five wide on the bend and also gradually drifted out through the lane. CHAR'S BOB'N ROBIN gradually angled in on the backstretch, saved ground through the turn, advanced just off the rail upper stretch then finished evenly. RICK'S TAVERN crowded briefly leaving the chute, showed no speed two to four wide and had no late bid. ILLINI MO was hustled along from outside, faded three wide on the bend, fanned out further into the stretch and continued to give way.
