Footnotes

A TOUCH OF HUMOR broke in stride, was soon inside, moved clear of RODEO JILL leaving the turn, was put to a drive midstretch and held the latter at bay under steady handling. RODEO JILL raced closest to A TOUCH OF HUMOR from just outside, floated out some into the lane, slowly made up ground deep stretch and was never challenged for the place. OLIVE CAN void of speed, was three wide on the turn, angled in some entering the stretch and moved clear for third late. MIAZA chased the top pair from just off the inside, took the rail into the lane and slowly wore down inside the final furlong. AMANDA'S PRIDE soon trailed from outside, gradually moved to the inside nearing the bend, saved ground through the turn and lacked a significant stretch response. SARA'S GOLDMINE was steadied as she tried to bear in at the start, appeared difficult to control leaving the chute and gradually moved toward the outside, was widest taking the turn and empty for the drive.
