Footnotes

SONGANDDANCELADY steadied briefly along the rail when outrun into the first turn, was settled, commenced her bid from inside going to the second bend, swung out three wide on that turn, fanned out further for the stretch run, took over with a sixteenth to go and began to draw clear under urging. SASSY BUCK gradually progressed inside to gain the lead at the top of the stretch, moved clear, floated out some after entering the last eighth, was all out but could not hold on. JOYCE G broke inward, bumping WINDS DUE EAST, was soon well back, slowly made up ground on the backstretch, progressed just off the inside through the second bend, angled out widest upper stretch, gradually made up ground and was clearly best of the rest. PERFECT CUP OF TEA gradually lost position from paths two or three for six furlongs, launched her bid into the lane, had a striking position as she altered inside for a clear path midstretch but could not sustain her bid through the waning yards. WINDS DUE EAST bumped at the start, contested the pace outside VELVET ACCOUNT, came into the lane three wide, began to wear down and was jostled briefly inside the final sixteenth. VELVET ACCOUNT broke alertly, was hustled along to vie for the lead just off the rail, also weakened for the drive, slowly drifted out under left-handed pressure in the late going and jostled with WINDS DUE EAST. OLE GRAY void of speed while toward the outside, angled in on the second bend, steadily gave way, was distanced from the field in the stretch, finished the course and was walked off.
