Footnotes

PEORIA STAR soon shared the lead between horses, moved clear and stayed just off the inside taking the bend, was asked midstretch and kept to task until the waning yards. DAVY'S CAT broke in stride, was soon challenged from inside, could not stay with PEORIA STAR while three wide through the turn, moved clear for second upper stretch then could only just hold her position in the late going. GRECO'S SECRET bumped with JOEFINE at the break, recovered quickly to prompt the pacesetters from outside, four wide on the bend, fought for third as she closed the gap on the weakening DAVY'S CAT and just lasted for the show. JOEFINE bumped from both sides at the start, trailed between horses, three to five wide taking the turn, altered out to path six for room midstretch and was closing well. WINDS DUE EAST was steadied when her path along the rail narrowed nearing the end of the first furlong, had the inside on the turn, angled out behind PEORIA STAR for the stretch run, battled for third but could only make up minor ground late. SWELL SPELL chased from outside, was also three to five wide through the bend, dueled for third as well in the lane and slowly closed the gap. MISS BOCEPHUS had the gate on her left side bounce back after opening, forcing her to break outward into JOEFINE at the start, she rushed up between horses to vie for the lead from inside after a furlong, was no match for PEORIA STAR leaving the turn and gave way for the drive. There was a stewards' inquiry into MISS BOCEPHUS' start. After their review, it was determined MISS BOCEPHUS did not receive a fair start and she was declared a non-starter for wagering purposes only.
