APT TO DANCE stalked the early speed from inside, commenced her bid along the rail leaving the turn, drew clear upper stretch and held off DONTFLATERYOURSELF under steady urging in the late going. DONTFLATERYOURSELF tried to bear out at the start, bumped solidly with DANCE WITH A FROST, was settled inside, progressed along the rail on the bend, swung out five entering the stretch, made a strong move under a drive the final furlong, closed the gap on the leader as she pulled away for second. SUM DAY SUM MAY in contention just off the inside, took the rail into the bend, lacked the needed stretch bid, gained third inside the last furlong, angled out some for a clear path with a sixteenth to go but could only lengthen her hold on the show. THIRTYNGREY forwardly placed outside on the backstretch, was just off the rail on the turn, failed to keep up as she fanned four wide for the stretch run and had no rally. MARYLOU'S SONG helped prompt the early pace from between rivals, was three wide through the turn then wore down for the drive. REBA RED showed first, set the pace from between rivals, was just off the rail on the turn, could not stay with APT TO DANCE upper stretch and flattened out the last furlong. DANCE WITH A FROST broke inward and bumped solidly with DONTFLATERYOURSELF, was steadied, showed no speed from outside, took the turn just off the rail and steadily gave way through the lane.
