Footnotes

THIS HERE GUITAR bumped with THE BOYD STORE at the start, was settled inside, waited for room on the turn, fanned out some entering the lane, was still blocked, squeezed through five wide with a sixteenth left and began to move clear nearing the wire. COURT COMPOSER moved inside midway on the backstretch, advanced along the rail on the turn, swung out five wide for a clear path into the stretch, angled out a bit nearing the sixteenth pole, could not hold back THIS HERE GUITAR but caught PRAIRIE PRINCE for second. PRAIRIE PRINCE kept close from outside, was three then four wide through the turn, edged ahead upper stretch but did not have enough left in the late going. PLEASANT TIGER displayed early speed, did not keep up on the turn, was two wide leaving the bend, came again upper stretch but could not sustain his bid. SOUTHERN DREAMER broke inward, also bumping THE BOYD STORE, was settle well off the inside, picked up his pace on the turn, lost considerable ground fanning to the middle of the track for the stretch run and showed a willingness to run late. RINKA BLINKA contested the pace from outside, had the lead three wide leaving the turn, began to yield some upper stretch, was steadied in close quarters shortly after entering the last furlong and continued to fade. EL CHANSEY sent to duel for the lead between rivals, gained the rail on the bend but began to tire entering the stretch. THE BOYD STORE bumped from both sides at the start, was an early factor between horses but faded two wide leaving the turn. MIESQUE'S SHADOW soon trailed, had the rail on the turn, floated out some into the stretch and was empty.
