Footnotes

LADY RISS settled outside the first half mile, picked up her pace three wide on the second turn, took over the lead nearing the last eighth and was driven clear. PROVEN CAT showed first, shared the early lead outside PADDLE'S BIG GIRL, drew clear on the second turn, could not hold back LADY RISS the final furlong but was clearly second best. MISS PRECOCITY backed up between rivals early, commenced a mild bid three wide on the second turn and pulled clear for third the last sixteenth. PADDLE'S BIG GIRL battled for the early lead inside, failed to sustain her speed on the second turn and flattened out in the lane. SPRINGBRAKEMISTAKE trailed off the rail for more than a half mile and only passed tired ones the last quarter mile. HELLO MIAMI leaned on the gate breaking in the air, moved up between rivals on the backstretch, saved ground through the second turn and lacked a stretch response. PHONE JOAN chased the leaders three wide for more than four furlongs before giving way between horses on the second turn. SHE WHO DANCES steadily faded inside.
