MISTER broke alertly, showed the way just off the inside, had the rail on the bend, floated out some into the lane, slowly drifted out inside the last eighth, bumped with HOPPY'S LONG SHOT deep stretch but held on. HOPPY'S LONG SHOT pressed from inside, waited for room while boxed in on the turn, got through just outside MISTER upper stretch, gradually angled out as he closed the gap on the latter in the late going, bumpd with MISTER in the waning yards, came up short but was clearly second best. NATHAN CHICAGO forwardly placed inside, angled out nearing the turn, lost ground four wide on the bend, moved out further for a clear path upper stretch, took over third with a furlong left but could not closed the gap on the top pair late. IRISH HERITAGE a step slow at the break and into stride, advanced along the rail on the bend, swung widest for the stretch run and steadily improved position without threatening. UPPER NINETY bumped midway on the backstretch as he helped prompt the pace from outside, was three wide taking the bend, fanned out further for the drive and did not have enough left from between horses. WYATT S looking for room on the backstretch, angled out some just past the nine-sixteenths marker, bumped UPPER NINETY, was two wide between rivals through the turn then also gradually yielded in the lane. THACKER HENRY chased from between horses, moved to the inside on the bend and had no stretch bid. ITTY BITTY YANKEE steadily faded in a wide trip.
