Footnotes

CAP'N SWIFTER was quickly clear, just off the rail through the bend, asked into the lane then steadily opened up while under urging until the waning yards. KATIE'S LADY in the second flight just off the inside, had the rail on the turn, fanned out to path three for the stretch run and took over second inside the final sixteenth. STORMIN BON showed first, was soon chasing CAP'N SWIFTER while toward the outside, moved clear for second just off the rail on the bend, drifted out to path five for the stretch run, slowly wore down but was easily best of the rest. CHICAGO CALI was also a contender from inside on the backstretch, retreated along the rail through the bend, fought for four in the lane and edged ahead of BROWN BISCUIT late. BROWN BISCUIT raced with CHICAGO CALI from just outside, battled that one for four through the stretch but did not have enough in the waning yards. FIERY CHICK a factor from outside early, gave way widest on the turn. LAYNEE BUG in the second flight between horses, gave way three wide through the turn.
