**Footnotes**

ECTON ACADEMY kept close from outside, began to improve position when roused five wide on the turn, was forced to fan out further entering the lane, began to gradually lug in as he gained the advantage under right-handed pressure nearing the sixteenth marker, was corrected, kept a straight path through the waning yards and held sway. WILDMAN MAC soon came off the rail to press the early speed from just outside, two wide through the bend, rallied to vie for the lead between horses approaching the sixteenth pole and floated out some as he began to level off nearing the wire. GOTCHA CART bumped with BETATRON then LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE leaving the chute, was steadied, taken to the outside, progressed three wide into and out of the bend, gradually closed the gap in the stretch, angled out as WILDMAN MAC came out in the waning yards and caught ILLINI DESTINY for third. ILLINI DESTINY showed first, soon had the lead and the rail, was clear through the bend but slowly wore down deep stretch. RUGER without early foot, took the rail into the turn, picked up his pace, swung two wide for the stretch run and steadily closed the gap. COACH ABS void of early speed from outside, trailed just off the rail on the bend, fanned four wide into the lane, lugged in some nearing the eighth pole, was corrected and made up ground late. BETATRON bumped with GOTCHA CART leaving the chute, raced in contention four wide, was carried out to path five entering the stretch and gradually wore down. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE bumped leaving the chute, was an early factor, gradually moved to the inside approaching the turn, failed to keep up though saving ground taking the bend and had no late bid. DOLLAR FACTOR in the second flight three wide, floated out further entering the stretch and gradually gave way. CALLINGTHEWEATHER prominent toward the outside on the backstretch, gave way four wide on the turn.
