OFFICER MCNEAL rated off the rail but inside his rivals through the early going, floated out a bit entering the stretch, was all out between rivals and held on. MIAMI ICE pressed OFFICER MCNEAL from just outside from the early going, slowly drifted out deep stretch and narrowly held second. TAXCO a step slow at the break, stayed behind OFFICER MCNEAL for six furlongs, moved to the rail nearing the quarter pole leaving the second turn then belatedly closed the gap through the stretch. DENO'S BIRDIE broke alertly but soon lost the lead, was kept close three wide through both bends, fanned out some for the drive and began to tire. THE MILE FRACTION WAS HAND TIMED.
