SEASCAPE soon had the lead, showed the way from inside, shook off WHAMMY'S BOY as he floated out some entering the second bend, was under a steady drive the final furlong and kept BIG RED OKIE at bay. BIG RED OKIE forwardly placed between rivals, was three wide on the second turn, angled in some for a clear path into the stretch, closed well, was too late but clearly second best. FLY BO FLY bumped at the start, raced in the second flight from along the rail and lacked the extra needed for the drive. BOIS D'ARC FOREST chased from outside, was three to five wide taking the second turn then gradually made up ground the last quarter mile and was closing in for third deep stretch. WHAMMY'S BOY bumped solidly with IZA OF ONYX shortly after the break, pressed SEASCAPE from just outside, could not keep up leaving the second turn, his rider lost his whip just after entering the last eighth and WHAMMY'S BOY continued to yield from between horses. ALLEYS GENERAL rank at the start, trailed from outside, moved inside midway on the backstretch, swung out widest for the stretch run and made up minor ground the last furlong. IZA OF ONYX broke inward, bumping solidly with FLY BO FLY, was then briefly squeezed between horses, steadied back, chased two to three wide and had no late bid.
