**Footnotes**

CLASSIC DEVIL an early contenders between horses, came four wide into the stretch, rallied under steady right-handed pressure, got the advantage seventy yards out and held on. STROKE OF GENIUS pressed AMAZINGLYGRACED from outside, took over four wide on the turn, floated out some into the lane, battled between rivals to hold on but was narrowly outfinished in a game effort. BEBOPPING GOLD settled well off the rail, lost considerable ground five to seven wide through the bend, closed with a rush in the stretch but was too late. GYPSEY HONEY soon trailed inside, made a strong bid along the rail in the upper stretch, was closing in late but outfinished. AMAZINGLYGRACED broke in stride, set the pace off the rail, was caught from outside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, tried hard but began to wear down the final sixteenth. STUKA'S DANCER raced in contention outside from the beginning, also lost ground through the bend, entered the stretch six out and found best stride too late. CITY PRAYER was well placed inside from the early going, failed to keep up along the rail on the bend, lodged a bid two wide in the stretch but could not keep up between rivals nearing the wire.
