Footnotes

BARRY K rated between horses, closed the gap just off the inside on the turn, swung out further for room entering the lane, moved clear under a drive, lugged in late but held sway. ONLY OBLONG away slowly, was hustled up from along the rail, angled out on the bend, fanned out behind BARRY K into the lane, altered out some for room upper stretch, gradually made up ground under a drive and caught RUSTY'S RED BOY for second. RUSTY'S RED BOY in the second flight between horses, gained the rail into the bend, loomed a threat midstretch, could not close the gap the last eighth but was easily best of the rest. ARTEMUS JOY without early speed from outside, lost ground widest through the turn, lacked a rally but improved his position some. BRAZEN GEORGE contested the pace from inside, floated out some entering the stretch, could not stay with BARRY K with a furlong to go and wore down in the late going. TIP FROM SKIP displayed early speed just outside BRAZEN GEORGE and also wore down the final eighth. MAC DOOGLE faded from between horses before finishing a quarter mile, angled in on the bend and was empty for the drive. SECRETO'S GOLD was a factor between horses for a half mile, came five wide into the stretch and had little left. THE QUARTER, HALF AND FIVE-FURLONG FRACTIONS WERE HAND TIMED.
