Footnotes

OCEAN SURGE rated off the early speed, quickly moved clear when let out two wide on the bend and proved much the best ridden out in the lane. CROSSWISE without early speed from inside, angled out leaving the bend, came three wide into the lane, battled for second and narrowly prevailed. HERE GUCCI delayed the start while fractious behind the gate, soon trailed once the race began, picked up her pace on the turn, swung widest for the drive, fought for second, missed but was clearly best of the rest. LUCKY TIP chased from outside, angled in on the bend, passed tired ones upper stretch then leveled off. MARYLOU'S SONG in contention from outside, was just off the rail on the turn, fanned four wide entering the stretch and gave way. SANTA TRINITA was quickly clear and inside, no match for OCEAN SURGE on the turn, floated out a bit into the lane and had little left. BAR HOPPIN void of speed just off the inside, pulled up on the turn and walked off. THE HALF MILE FRACTION WAS HAND TIMED.
