RAGGEDY HOBO shared the lead in hand from inside, moved clear on the second turn, responded to urging leaving that bend and gradually opened up through the lane while being kept to task. EAGLE EYE JUSTICE vied for the lead between rivals, could not stay with RAGGEDY HOBO on the second turn, fought for second upper stretch then shook off BLACKHAWK RED in the late going. BLACKHAWK RED forwardly placed just off the inside, advanced along the rail on the second turn, dueled for the place in the lane, wore down deep stretch but was easily best of the rest. N EIGHTEEN in contention between horses, moved to the inside at the halfway point, did not stay close on the second turn and had no stretch bid. SUNDAY SAINT advanced to contention from outside on the backstretch, failed to keep up four wide leaving the second turn and ran evenly through the lane. JUNIOR'S BOOST TOO in paths two or three throughout, only passed some tired ones in the stretch. JUST IN FRONT reluctant to load, was hustled up to contest the pace from outside once the race began but faded three wide between rivals leaving the second bend. PROPANE chased from inside to the second bend then gave way. AIDAN'S SLEW void of speed, was steadied behind traffic at the half mile marker, altered out, faded from outside on the second turn, was pulled up in the stretch and walked off.
