**Footnotes**

CANDY PASS rated toward the outside, circled rivals widest through the bend, gained the advantage nearing the eighth pole and shook free late. SMITTENBUTSPITTIN' in contention between horses, waited for room three wide through the turn, gained a clear path upper stretch, lugged in some as she vied for the lead midstretch but did not have enough left inside the final sixteenth. CLEOTA pressed from between rivals, went for the lead three wide on the bend, had the advantage into the lane, drifted out upper stretch and gradually yielded. HALFDRESSED prominent from outside, advanced four wide on the turn, floated out further into the stretch and also did not have enough left for the drive. HOT DAME well placed between horses, found herself boxed in behind BLUE JEANS N BOOTS leaving the turn, had a clear path just off the inside at the top of the lane, altered out some for room when SMITTENBUTSPITTIN' took her path midstretch but finished evenly. CHICAGO CALI without early speed while toward the outside, was two then three wide taking the turn, closed the gap upper stretch, began to wear down inside the last eighth and was angled in late. ALASKAN HOT ROD without speed, though hustled along from inside, saved ground through the bend, altered out some for a clear path midstretch, lacked a significant response and was forced in to stay clear of CHICAGO CALI in the waning yards. BLUE JEANS N BOOTS set the pace from inside, was challenged on the turn and flattened out for the drive. SURFIN WAVE in paths three or four throughout, showed little.
