Footnotes

RAY JAY soon had the advantage from path three but inside his closest rivals, moved clear just off the inside on the turn, was all out the last eighth and held off SPURTABILITY. The latter gradually progressed from inside, moved clear for second upper stretch then could only make up minor ground on RAY JAY late. HOLY BULLHIVE prominent from outside, was three wide taking the turn, lacked the extra needed for the drive but stayed clear for the show. CAP'N FELIX in contention early toward the outside, failed to keep up between rivals into the turn, moved to the rail leaving the bend and gradually closed the gap in the stretch without threatening. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE a factor on the backstretch, failed to keep up just off the inside on the turn, fanned four wide entering the stretch and lacked a significant response. NOAH'S TRAVELER soon trailed from outside, was three to five wide through the bend and had no late bid. SHICAGO SENSATION displayed early speed between horses but gave way two wide leaving the turn. LUCKY ALEC reared up at the break and lost his rider. There was a stewards' inquiry into LUCKY ALEC'S start but no action taken after their review.
