Footnotes

COLVILLE ZEAL rated just off the early speed from outside, took over two wide leaving the bend, moved clear, started drifting out near the eighth pole, held a straight course under a stern right whip the last sixteenth and held on. SASSY CHERYL broke alertly and was hustled clear, challenged from outside on the turn, lost the advantage, floated out some into the stretch, drifted out to path three with a furlong to go and was getting to COLVILLE ZEAL in the waning yards. FROSTY PETALS hesitated at the start, moved up between horses, angled out five wide into the turn, kept that path for the stretch run and found best stride too late. MINUS FOURTY FIVE in midpack early, reached contention two wide on the bend, slowly made up ground the last three-sixteenths but was outfinished. FIVE TWO SEVEN hit the gate breaking inward, advanced outside, four wide into the stretch and also gradually closed the gap. CONTESSA KRISTINE soon trailed but steadily progressed along the rail once on the bend. IRISH FORTUNE away slowly, was taken outside, four to five wide through the turn, angled out to path six for room nearing the eighth pole, also made up ground but could not improve her position.
