Footnotes

BOSTON OUTLAW stalked from outside, went for the lead three wide on the turn, angled in beside ROYALLY OUTFOXED into the lane, gained a narrow advantage inside the final furlong and gradually edged ahead under steady handling. DEW DETIME crowded at the start, was boxed in behind the early speed, angled out for room on the bend, came four wide into the stretch, slowly improved position without gaining much ground but got second late. ROYALLY OUTFOXED soon had the lead, showed the way just off the inside, was challenged on the turn and gradually yielded the final furlong. WOODY NORWOOD was prominent inside from the beginning, outrun into the turn, waited for a wider path, gained it midstretch but could not close the gap. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE well placed between rivals, began to tire two wide entering the lane. TARAFOX was also boxed in behind the pacesetters on the backstretch and gave way three wide leaving the bend. HONKY TONK GOLD unruly in the gate, was a bit awkward leaving the gate, ran in contention from outside on the backstretch but faded while widest on the turn.
