CERTIFIED COPY progressed between horses on the backstretch, closed the gap three wide through the bend, put to a drive upper stretch and got up in time. ROYAL INTEGRITY kept close just off the inside, took the rail into the turn, waited for room behind GOOD RIDE, got through two wide leaving the bend, took over upper stretch, was all out the last eighth but did not have enough left. PORTERVILLE without early foot from outside, commenced his bid behind CERTIFIED COPY on the turn, swung outside that one entering the lane, brushed and bumped with WILL'S HONEY midstretch, shook off that one approaching the sixteenth marker and found best stride too late. APACHE HONOR soon well back between other rivals, picked up his pace three wide on the bend, swung out to path five into the lane, drifted out upper stretch, held a straight path the final furlong and closed well. WILL'S HONEY also without early speed, ran just inside PORTERVILLE, bid with that one, came three wide into the lane, found himself boxed in behind CERTIFIED COPY, brushed and bumped with PORTERVILLE while blocked midstretch and gradually relented in the late going. GOOD RIDE was sent clear, soon had the rail and gradually wore down the last quarter mile. SINGALONGWITH BERT saved ground and lacked a stretch bid. SANDS RED B chased the early speed from between horses, was two wide taking the bend then slowly drifted out as he flattened for the drive. A J'S PAYDAY was soon well back, had the rail on the turn, came off the inside some for a clear path entering the stretch but failed to mount a significant response. MENTO INK appeared to swipe the gate as he left it, trailed from outside, angled in to be just off the rail on the turn, swung out as A J'S PAYDAY came out into the stretch and had no rally.
