**Footnotes**

MIAMI ICE settled inside, gradually picked up his pace, swung out five wide and circled horses on the second bend, took over inside the last furlong, steadily opened up and was under a drive until eighty yards from the wire. FUTURISTIC checked when his path was taken early in the first turn, was altered out some, advanced from inside on the backstretch, split horses three wide with a quarter mile to go, came into contention between rivals upper stretch, was no match for MIAMI ICE inside the last eighth but caught TIME ADOSIOUS for second. TIME ADOSIOUS broke alertly, steadily drew away from the rest while in hand, was put to a drive in the lane, no match for MIAMI ICE inside the final furlong and slowly wore down in the waning yards. DANCIN PEAK settled in midpack from inside, commenced his bid into the second turn, split rivals two wide midway on that bend to move clear for third but hung the last furlong. WATERSHED EVENT was soon far back, saved ground, picked up his pace after a half mile and passed tired ones in the stretch. GOLDFINDER chased the early speed from path three then began to tire between horses on the second turn. JAKE'S SOLDIER without speed from outside, gave way four wide on the second turn. SEYRULE in the second flight just off the inside, had the rail on the second bend, faltered in the lane and drifted out deep stretch. CRYPTO GULCH without speed while staying off the inside, was just off the rail on the second turn and empty for the drive.
