Footnotes

PRINCESS BUFFY whose rider did not carry a whip, was a bit slow at the start, as she turned her head just as the gate opened, progressed inside, took over as she floated out one path midstretch, was soon clear and held off LIQUID MOTION under steady handling. LIQUID MOTION jostled between rivals shortly after the start, was shuffled back, advanced just off the inside through the bend, angled inside PRINCESS BUFFY deep stretch and was closing in on that one as she pulled away from the rest. AUNDREYA drifted out some to bump LIQUID MOTION just after the break, pressed the early speed from just outside, in paths three then four taking the turn, dueled for the lead upper stretch but could not sustain her bid late. CHASE'N MARYKAY broke alertly, showed the way just off the rail, floated out further into the stretch and gradually wore down. SHAKEEL'S BEST also jostled early between horses, trailed from outside, was three wide on the turn, swung out to path five for the stretch run, altered out after entering the last furlong and passed a couple tired ones. FLASHY DOLL in contention just off the inside on the backstretch but faded along the rail through the bend. ITSALLMINEBABE forwardly placed between horses, gave way three wide on the turn. MAW KETTLE bumped just after the start, was a factor from outside on the backstretch, failed to stay close widest through the turn and gradually yielded in the stretch.
