Footnotes

HOLY ARMENIA fractious in the gate, was rated off the early speed, commenced his bid leaving the turn, took over inside the final furlong and gradually drew off from the rest. ROADSTER without early foot, started his bid leaving the turn and got up for second nearing the wire. HONKY TONK GOLD well placed just off the early speed, lacked the necessary stretch bid, fought for second the final sixteenth but was outfinished. LUCKY ALEC unruly in the gate, moved up from inside to gain the early lead, lengthened command on the turn, could not hold back HOLY ARMENIA inside the last eighth, battled to keep second but did not have enough left. RELEASE ME NOW in contention from the beginning, failed to have a serious late bid. JUST LUKE void of speed, showed late interest without threatening. BIG SIX was a factor on the backstretch but steadily gave way once on the bend. SUITED DEUCES was soon well back and showed little.
