Footnotes

RACHEL HAY settled off the inside, angled in and picked up her pace when asked on the turn, was blocked upper stretch, altered out four wide nearing the furlong, took over inside the final sixteenth and was drawing off. MISS BOCEPHUS in midpack toward the outside on the backstretch, closed the gap four wide on the turn, was carried out to path six into the lane, lodged a mild bid and got up for second near the wire. MAKIN ART SMILE broke in stride, was soon challenged from inside, dueled for the lead two wide until deep stretch, fought for second after that but was outfinished. LUCY'S MISS was sent to contest the pace from inside, was no match for RACHEL HAY inside the final sixteenth, battled to keep second but did not have enough left. JOEFINE void of speed from inside, saved ground taking the bend and passed a few tired ones in the stretch. CART LITE hesitated at the start, showed no speed from outside, two wide on the turn, swung out to path five into the stretch, altered out to the middle of the track for room nearing the final furlong and was improving her position. JET POWER altered out a couple times for room on the backstretch, took the bend four wide, moved in some for a clear path nearing the furlong marker then lacked a late bid. RACHEL'S STORM chased the pacesetters from just outside, drifted out to path five into the stretch and began to tire.
