Footnotes

BEAUCOUP GOLD in contention between rivals, was steadied behind traffic early in the turn, split horses four wide with a quarter mile to go, angled in some entering the stretch, rallied under a steady drive, gained the advantage inside the final sixteenth and shook off DOUGHNUT MAN in the waning yards. DOUGHNUT MAN advanced just off the inside to gain the lead, saved ground through the turn, tried hard in the lane but did not have enough left deep stretch. STORM CROSSED prominent from outside, failed to keep up while four then five wide through the bend and found best stride too late inside the final furlong. SHEKINAH without speed from inside, picked up his pace along the rail on the turn, altered out six wide at the top of the stretch for a clear path, closed well but also belatedly. SABAGO forwardly placed while widest on the backstretch, gradually angled in as he circled rivals on the bend, was just off the inside entering the stretch, was challenged for second shortly after that and slowly yielded. ROYAL INTEGRITY an early factor just off the inside, had the rail through the turn, fought for second upper stretch and also did not have enough left in the late going. BULL BAYOU in the second flight between horses, was three wide on the bend then weaved in and out as he tired in the stretch. POWERFULLY soon trailed from outside, was just off the rail on the turn, floated out into the stretch and was empty. FREEDOM CAMP pressed the pacesetter from just outside, was two wide on the bend, began to fade leaving the turn, angled out some for a clear path upper stretch and steadily gave way.
