Footnotes

RAY JAY was sent to the lead, soon moved clear, saved ground and drew off under a mild drive in the lane. MIDNITE KID without early foot, improved position along the rail on the turn, responded to mostly hand urging in the stretch and caught MUNSTER DOWN UNDER for second in the waning yards. MUNSTER DOWN UNDER chased RAY JAY from just off the inside from the beginning, slowly wore down for the drive but was clearly best of the rest. COPPER LEASE in midpack between rivals on the backstretch, took the turn three wide and lacked a stretch rally. DEVIL'S BEAU without speed from inside, was just off the rail into the lane, altered out four wide nearing the furlong marker and made up minor ground late. MIDRANGE soon backed up from between horses, lost ground taking the turn four to six wide and was slowly closing the gap the final furlong. CHOKER SETTER in midpack from outside, was four and five wide through the turn, angled out to the middle of the track when his path narrowed upper stretch and proved empty. KING TOM THE GREAT hesitated at the break, advanced between rivals, was just off the inside on the turn, fanned four wide for the stretch run, drifted out a bit going to the eighth pole and steadily gave way. ROCKIN RILEY reared and thrashed about when the gate opened and lost his rider. There was a stewards' inquiry into ROCKIN RILEY'S start but no action taken after their review.
