Footnotes

DONTFLATERYOURSELF rated from outside, was put to a drive three wide on the bend, fanned out to path five entering the stretch, responded to steady urging, took over inside the final sixteenth and began to draw off. BARELY FRIENDS showed first, disputed the pace from outside, moved ahead two wide on the turn, battled to hold on through the lane but did not have enough to hold back DONTFLATERYOURSELF deep stretch. ROBINS INTA WIN vied for the lead inside from the early going, failed to have the needed late kick but was clearly best of the rest. SUPER COXIE was soon blocked just behind BARELY FRIENDS, moved outside that one near the half mile marker, made her move three wide on the turn, floated out further into the stretch and gradually wore down. CHICAGO CALI trailed, was just off the rail into the bend, gradually angled out to come into the stretch five wide then improved her position without making up ground. SHECANGOALLTHEWAY in the second flight between rivals, was in tight quarters briefly midway on the backstretch, advanced along the rail on the bend, came off the inside some for the stretch run and tired. SUM DAY SUM MAY was a factor between horses on the backstretch but faded just off the rail on the turn. STORMY RACHEL well placed inside early, was steadied along the rail into the turn and quickly gave way.
