Footnotes

TACTICS RAP blocked early, got through three wide midway on the backstretch, went for the lead on the second bend, angled in some entering the stretch and drew clear under a drive the last eighth. CIARA FOR THREE settled, gradually progressed outside on the backstretch, came into contention two wide on the second turn, fanned out to path four into the stretch, made up some ground late and caught SEATTLE TRAIN for the place. SEATTLE TRAIN advanced between horses to help prompt the early speed, lost ground four wide on the second turn, also angled in some for the stretch run, took over second inside the last eighth, was no match for TACTICS RAP and slowly yielded. ALASKAN PARADOX bumped with NAJCAT at the start and again going to the first turn as she moved up between rivals to vie for the early lead, was two wide taking the second turn and also did not have enough left for the drive. WENDY'S JOY gradually progressed inside to have a striking position with three furlongs left, began to yield as she angled out leaving the second turn and continued to fade as she gradually angled toward the outside in the lane. LUCKY LIPSTICK was a contender from outside to the second bend then gave way. NAJCAT bumped with ALASKAN PARADOX at the start and again nearing the first bend, contested the pace from inside for nearly six furlongs then began to tire.
