Footnotes

MR. MINK reluctant to load, quickly drew off to a commanding lead once the race began, saved ground and held on under steady urging the final furlong. CANYON DE ORO gradually progressed inside, was angled out some on the second turn, moved outside ROBIN ZEE into the stretch, rallied three wide, could not catch MR. MINK but was easily second best. MAJOR DUNDEE bumped with MOUNT TORA BORA at the start, raced closest to MR. MINK through the early going, saved ground through the second turn and lacked a stretch bid. ROBIN ZEE settled outside the first half mile, picked up his pace nearing the second turn, was angled in beside MAJOR DUNDEE on that bend and also wore down in the lane. MEDLIN ROAD dwelt at the start, spotting the rest of the field many lengths, moved up between horses on the backstretch but failed to respond two to three wide the last quarter mile. MOUNT TORA BORA bumped with MAJOR DUNDEE at the break, quickly dropped back three wide going to the halfway point and showed little after that.
