LIL SUSIE TOO was quickly clear, saved ground, roused leaving the turn, began to drift out inside the last furlong but lengthened command under some corrective urging. CORNER GIRL settled just off the inside, was steadied slightly and altered out to stay clear of CHECK MY DADDY near the turn, was just off the rail on the bend, altered out five wide upper stretch for room and got second late. HARASSMENT chased from between rivals, angled in on the bend, battled for second along the rail in the stretch, was crowded in the waning yards, steadied but edged ahead for third. SECA TREACE closest to the early speed, stayed just off the inside on the bend, floated out some entering the lane, fought for second, lugged in deep stretch and was outfinished. MARYLOU'S SONG chased from outside, was three then four wide taking the turn then weakened for the drive. TAP DAZZLER was away a step slowly, raced wide and failed to menace. CHECK MY DADDY began to be pulled up in distress shortly after the first furlong and was vanned off.
